2018-2019 Tuition Rates and Payment Policies

Ballet U offers three different dance divisions.

1. **Preschool classes (Tiny Dancers, Leap 'N Learn 3 and Leap 'N Learn 4, which are offered in 11 or 12 week sessions. Students need to re-enroll for each session, each session is paid in full at the time of registration.**

Fall Session: 8/20-11/5 (11 wks)
Winter Session: 11/6-2/16 (12 wks)
Spring Session: 2/18-5/18 (12 wks)

2. **School year programs (Preballet, Youth I-V, Basic Ballet for 8-13, optional add-on classes) are offered during 35 weeks of lessons between 8/20/18 and 5/18/19.**

Annual tuition payments are made in **9 monthly installments**: Make initial payment plus registration fee at time of registration, remaining 8 payments are due on the 15th of each month (Sept.-April).

All families must use auto-pay and enter credit card information at time of registration.

Ballet U classes are structured on a full year syllabus, making it extremely important for students (and parents) to commit to enrollment for an entire school year. If you need to withdraw your child before the end of the school year a 30 days written notice is required, otherwise your account will be charged accordingly.

The tuition payment policy applies regardless of student attendance. No credit or refunds for missed classes, including private lessons. Make-up classes may be arranged at the discretion of the director. Medical deferments are given with written physician's excuse as credit in the term following the injury-absence.

3. **Adult Ballet Classes (Open Division) offered year-round**
With the exception of our 6 week intro classes for new beginners all adult ballet classes are offered on a drop-in basis.

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Studio Policies

- ◆ A locker room with showers is available for changing. Hang all streetwear, coats and shoes in observation hallway. Bring valuables into class.
- ◆ Wear street clothes or warm-ups over dancewear when outside of the studio. Do not wear dance shoes outdoors.
- ◆ Students in our children's and youth classes are required to follow our dress code. Ballet U, LLC is a professional school with professional faculty who expect proper attire and neatness.
- ◆ Please no food/gum/drink other than closed water bottles in studio.
- ◆ Please, no sitting, standing, running, playing/loud voices in entrance lobby. Move to observation hallway to wait. Use indoor voices and refrain from climbing or physical game playing in observation hall. Sounds from the observation hall are amplified into the studio.
- ◆ Because we cannot see the lobby, do not drop off or pick up students under 12 at the door. Please call if you will be later than 15 minutes after class for pick up, student will be asked to wait in the studio.
- ◆ Classes begin on time and students should plan to arrive 10-15 minutes early to be prepared. Late admittance to class is at the teacher's discretion. Tardy students may be asked to observe class. This is to ensure the students safety as well as to not disrupt the flow of the class.
- ◆ Class observation is always welcome from the observation area. Several times a year there will be observation classes, where parents and other family/friends can sit in the studio and observe.
- ◆ Classes with insufficient enrollment are subject to cancellation.
- ◆ Ballet U, LLC reserves the right to occasionally photograph/videotape students for use in advertising and training.
- ◆ Students are requested to email prescheduled absences to info@balletu.com or call or text (608) 620-5598 if less than 24 hours notice. Good attendance is critical to consistent progress and advancement. We encourage each student to make up any missed classes. Missed classes may be made up at the same or lower class level.
- ◆ Ballet U, LLC does not offer credit or make-up classes outside regular class hours for student or act of nature cancellations, but students are invited to try another class at current level or one level above or below theirs to make-up during the same session in which classes are missed. If Ballet U, LLC cancels for any other reason, make-up classes may be offered at the director's discretion.
- ◆ School closing due to severe weather: Ballet U classes may be cancelled if weather conditions make travel unsafe. Please check your email, the website or our Facebook page or call (608) 620-5598 for the latest information.
- ◆ Ballet U, LLC reserves the right to provide a substitute teacher if the regular teacher is ill or otherwise unavailable.
