

Dress Code

Students in our children's and youth classes are required to follow our dress code which has been established to create unity and discipline. For your convenience, leotards, tights and ballet shoes are available for purchase at Ballet U. You may also purchase items online through our registration site and pick them up at the studio.

Students are expected to be in dress code by the 3rd week of classes.

Tiny Dancers	Pink or lilac skirted leotard, no separate skirt, pink tights, pink ballet slippers	Black shorts or athletic pants, white t-shirt, black leather ballet slippers
PreBallet 3 & 4	Pink or lilac skirted leotard, no separate skirt, pink tights, pink ballet slippers	Black shorts or athletic pants, white t-shirt, black leather ballet slippers
PreBallet 5 & 6	Light blue (PB5/6) or Sea Foam (PB6/7) skirted leotard, pink tights, pink ballet slippers	Black shorts or dance pants, white t-shirt, black leather ballet slippers
Youth 1 Ballet	Peacock (Y1A) or Plum (Y1B) leotard, no skirt, pink tights, pink ballet slippers	Black shorts or leggings/tights, white t-shirt, black leather ballet slippers
Youth 2 Ballet	Grape (Y2A), Black Cherry (Y2B), Pine (Y2C) leotard, pink tights, pink ballet slippers. No skirt.	Black shorts or leggings/tights, white t-shirt, black leather ballet slippers
Youth 3 to 5 Ballet	Black leotard, pink tights, leather or canvas ballet slippers. No skirt.	Black bike-shorts or tights, white t-shirt, black leather ballet slippers
Adult Ballet	Leotard and tights or workout clothing, ballet slippers, ballet skirts are optional	Athletic pants or shorts, t-shirt, ballet slippers

All dancewear should be clean and in good repair.

Warm-ups may only be worn with instructor's permission.

Youth 3 and 4 - No skirts, except for occasional special occasions.

Underwear - please NO visible panties or bras

No jewelry with the exception of small stud earrings

Hair

Dancers in our PreBallet classes should have their hair pulled away from face and shoulders (ponyta il, pig tails or bun). Dancers in our Youth 1 and up classes wear their hair tightly secured off face with headband/clips and long hair attached to the back of the head with bobby pins. Bun making instructions can be found on our website.

Hygiene

Dancers are expected to practice good hygiene. Use deodorant and wash dancewear after each use. Please avoid strongly scented body sprays or lotions.
